CENTRAL VALLEY — The Orange County Chinese School opens Saturday, September 6 for the 2014-2015 school year, providing Chinese language (Mandarin) courses to students of all ages in the Hudson Valley region.

The Orange County Chinese School locates at the Central Valley

Elementary School with a mission to serve the community and individuals who are interested in learning the Chinese language and culture. The Chinese School follows the Monroe Woodbury School District schedule. Classes are on Saturdays from 9:30am-12:30 pm with language classes running from 9:30am to 11:30am and culture classes running from 11:40am to 12:30pm. Students of all skill levels are welcome to participate. Parents are welcome to sit with their younger children in the classroom in order to be more involved in their learning process. The Chinese school was established in 1986 by a few families in the area. Over the years, it has grown into a school with more than 100 students at times. Along with the Orange County Chinese Association, the Chinese school has been recognized as the local resource for Chinese culture and language and has earned a reputation of being an innovative program in which students excel in their Chinese reading, Chinese knowledge and

为了及时有效地做好审计和报税等方面的工作,设立标准化的OCCA财务操作准则。

- 1, 每年一月底之前把 1099 表寄到员工 (薪) 手上。
- 2, 每年二月底之前把准备好的 1099 和 1096 表寄到国税部门。
- 3, 每年六月十五号之前把用于协会免税许可的 E Z 990 表寄到国税部门。
- 4, 使用标准化财会软件分类各项 OCCA 收入与支出。
- 5, 每个季度需要向董事会通报财政收支状况。
- 6, 严格执行财务管理制度:
 - 百元以下非校长开支,校长签字即可报销,否则由会长签字。 百元以下非会长开支,会长签字即可报销,否则由校长签字。 百元以上,会长和校长或会计至少两人签字后,方可报销。 两百五十元以上开销,需要董事会讨论通过,方可执行。 所有支票报销单上需要两人签字方可。
- 7, 大量现金过帐时,需要由董事会指定除财务之外的另一人直接 参与。
- 8, 增加或削减教师,需要经董事会通过,并由财务备案。
- 9, 学费收取不论现金还是支票,均需要开出电子财务收据单。
- **10**,中文学校与华人协会项目收支需要分列出来,以明确收支平衡情况。
- 11, 每年及时办理 O C C A 邮政信箱和协会团体保险续约

我和中文学校 2005 届中文学校毕业生 曹辰

虽然我离开中文学校有差不多十年了,我永远不会忘记那里的美好回忆。

我在中文学校不光学了怎么说汉语和怎么写汉字,同时也体验了无价的中国文化。读中国历史,听中文小说,跟同学们玩象棋,参加春节晚会......,这些活动对我的华裔美国人身份有很大的影响。当时我不懂得学中文有多么的重要。在青春期的时候,我对中文学校有一个很不好的态度。我的想法是:"我的美国朋友都能每个星期六睡懒觉,为什么我必须得早早起床去上课呢?"只有等到离开家去上大学之后,我才开始了解为什么小时候父母执意送我去中文学校。我在大学见到很多在美国长大的中国孩子不会讲中文。他们对中国文化也不感兴趣。虽然我一直在美国生活和读书,我还是把自己看作一个中国人。因为,我会说国语,也会写汉字,这些都帮助我保存我的中国心。

中文学校在我生命中是一个非常重要的组成部分。

Although I left the Chinese school almost ten years ago, I will never forget the everlasting memories I gained there. It not only taught me how to speak and write Chinese, but gave me the opportunity to experience Chinese culture. Reading Chinese history, reciting poems, playing chess with fellow students, watching and participating in the Spring Festival Gala, these activities had a great impact on my identity as a Chinese-American.

Growing up, I did not understand the importance of learning Chinese. As a teenager, I did not have a very healthy attitude towards attending Chinese school. My thinking was: "My American friends can sleep in every Saturday, why do I have to get up early and go to class?" Only after leaving home to go to college did I begin to understand why my parents insisted on sending me to Chinese school . I met a lot of Chinese-American friends and classmates that did not speak the language. They were also disconnected and uninterested in their home culture. Although I have been living and studying in the United States for all of my life, I still see myself as a Chinese person. My ability to speak and write Mandarin helps me preserve my Chinese heart.

Therefore, Chinese school was an integral part of my life.

Woodbury Commons 打工面试趣事

今年暑期来临之前,我的父母认为我应该在附近的 Woodbury Commons Outlets 找一份短期的暑期工作,这样可以增长我的社会知识和提高我的独立生活能力,于是我在六月底的时候开始寻找打工的机会。通过这次打工经历,我更加意识到学好中文和说好普通话的重要性了。现在我就和我们中文学校的同学们分享一下我在Outlets 找工作的有趣经历。

第一是努力地申请面试机会。开始的时候,有朋友告诉我妈妈 Hugo Boss 和 Kate Spade New York 两家品牌店要招会说中文的员工。于是我和我的另一个会讲中文的朋友一起去这两家店拿工作申请表,顺便要求见经理。经理们知道我会说普通话的时候,非常高兴,他们说每天他们都要接待很多来自中国的顾客,可是苦于不懂他们在说什么,沟通很困难,常常闹笑话。不过因为我没有满 18 岁,最后我没有被录用,但是他们都要求我留下联系方式,他们说他们太需要会说中文的员工了。由于年龄太小,没有了工作的机会,我有些着急,我爸爸和妈妈鼓励我不要放弃,再试一试其他的品牌店。于是,我在网上申请了 Gap,Nike,Levis 等招收不满 18 岁高中生的品牌店,又填写了 Polo Ralph Lauren 和 Tommy Hilfiger 两份申请表。无论是网上申请,还是手写,我都特别强调我的父母是中国人,我会讲中文。一个多星期过去后,我很惊讶地收到了很多面试的邀请,最后我选择了一个自己喜欢的美国品牌店打工。我妈妈老是开玩笑地说我找到工作的主要原因不是由于我勤奋努力,而是因为我是中国人。

第二是做好回答面试问题的准备工作。面试之前,我到网站上了解我感兴趣品牌的历史和相关资料,同时我自己还准备了好几个可能要问到的问题,比如说你为什么喜欢我们的品牌?我们为什么要招聘你?请谈谈我们品牌在国际上的影响等等。其实我最担心的是面试官会不会问一些脑筋急转弯的问题。记得我哥哥罗凯文在一家美国大公司进入第三次面试时就被问到这样一个问题:你觉得猫和冰箱的共同点在哪里?我哥哥当时急中生智地回答到:猫和冰箱的内心都是冰冷的。他的巧妙的回答得到了考官的笑容和肯定。还好,我面试时被问到的问题都是一些非常基本的问题,比如说,请介绍一下你自己,让我们了解你一下,或者如果有15个顾客同时要试衣服,你怎么办?还有你可以什么时候上班等等。我有一点失望,因为我准备好的其中的一个问题他们没问我,那就是你能不能推荐一下你就读的橙郡中文学校?

在这里我还告诉你一个小秘密,我打工的这家服装店那一次只招聘了两个会说中文高中的女孩子,其中的一个就是我。天啊,难道真让我妈妈说对了,我主要是因为会讲中文才被录取的?由此可见,我们学习中文文化和坚持说中文是非常重要的。
