OCCA prepares the Celebration of the Year of the Sheep Daniel Jiang

The Chinese New Year celebration, also called the Spring Festival, is the most important festival in the Chinese culture. The Spring Festival, which celebrates family reunion, is full of rich and colorful cultural activities. The 2015 Chinese New Year falls on February 19. According to the Chinese Zodiac, 2015 is the year of the sheep. To provide a venue for local families to continue on the tradition of the Chinese New Year, the Orange County Chinese Association (OCCA) and the Orange County Chinese School are hosting a celebration gala on February 14, 2015 from 2pm to 10pm at the Central Valley Elementary School in Central Valley, New York. This festivity is a part of the continuous efforts of the OCCA to promote greater multicultural awareness on the basis of supporting cultural tolerance, creating a vibrant cultural community, and fostering an increased support amongst residents within the local community.

"Our celebration is comprised of a show and a dinner." the program co-manager, Mr. Kangjian Wu said. "This culturally enriching day for our community will celebrate the most important time of year in the Chinese culture - the annual Chinese New Year celebration". The show is performed by adults (volunteers and invited professionals) from our association and the students of the Orange Country Chinese School. The professional program includes: Acrobats, Kung Fu professionals. Chinese court dancers, etc. Each program is full of Chinese characteristics. "All of the classes at the Chinese School will perform on the stage," program co-manager, Mrs. Qian He added. "Adult class students will act as well; this is the first time in the 28 years of the Chinese School history".

This program is funded, in part, by the Orange County Tourism and the County of Orange and is open to the public. "We welcome everyone in the community to come observe and be a part of the celebration," stated Mr. Jim Jiang, "You will have an opportunity to see with your own eyes how people from different regions and different ethnic groups of China celebrate the Chinese New Year in a unique way within our local area."

The theme of this year's celebration is "from the Community, to the Community, for a better Community," Mr. Jiang continued. ---- Meeting Minutes for the Preparatory Meeting----

The preparatory meeting for the 2015 Chinese New Year celebration was held on Dec 13, 2014 at the Chinese School from 10am to 11:30am. OCCA board members (Pak Leung, Du Jinlin, Qian He, Wu Kevin, Wu Kangjian, Zhang Guiying, Robert Hui, and Jim Jiang) and some of the volunteers (Chiring Leung, Kent Leung, Susan Qu, Andy Kuo, Zhao Xiaolan, Denise Dong, and Peng Xiaodong) attended the meeting.

- 1) **Jim Jiang updated the fundraiser status:** Approximately total of \$4000 have been pledged or paid in the past few weeks. Hopefully more than \$5000 will be raised for the celebration.
- 2) Qian He updated the team the OCCS Programs: OCCS have finalized school programs and the list of OCCS programs was distributed to all attendees for review. The programs include two talent show awarded programs and programs from each classroom. This is the first time in OCCS history that adult class will be performing on the stage as well. All OCCS programs may take more than one hour.
- 3) Kangjian Wu updated the OCCA Programs. The OCCA programs are almost finalized. The show is performed by adults (volunteers and invited professionals) from our association. The professional programs includes: Acrobats, Kung Fu professionals, Chinese court dancers, etc.
- 4) Robert Hui and Kent Leung will work together on the Stage Design. The actual budget will be decided when they decide how to proceed. Stage lights will be very crucial this year as we have many dance programs. CVES will grant us an access to the stage light apparatus. Kent will bring back the same audio system for the celebration as the last year. Jimmy Cheng,

Vincent Leong, Deng Chenghua, Peng Xiaodong, Robert Hui and Kent Leung will work together for the stage operations.

5) **Ke vin Wu will working on Food Catering**. We will order food from our sponsors. Though we discussed different ways to serve food, we will meet again to discuss further for the best option. The price for the dinner:

Children 4 and younger: Free; Children 5 to 14: \$8; Adults-member: \$10:

Dinner Tickets will be on sale starting on January 10 when OCCS re-open for school.

- 6) Xu Ping will lead the team for the decoration of Hallways and Entry. Xu Ping will provide design proposal and budget. More volunteers needed.
- 7) Li Na and Tracy Hui will work on the Decoration of the Cafeterias. Li Na and Tracy will provide design proposal and budget.
- 8) The Stage Coordination is very critical. Same group of the volunteers will work together again for a better operation. Many suggestions have been discussed and details will be further discussed. Chiring Leung will serve a Stage Manager who coordinates the activities from the back stage (Susan Qu, Denise Dong) and front stage (Guiving Zhang, Zhao Xiaolan).
- 9) Liao Hong, Tang June, Tracy Hui, Mei Jia, Qun Dong, Eunice Yun, Yiman Han, and Xiuquan Shi etc. will work for the various positions at the front reception desk. These jobs include membership registration, board vote, dinner ticket sale, beverage sale, raffle ticket sale and greetings etc.

- 10) **Yang Wei** will edit the program brochure and **Rose Leung** will be photographer for the event.
- 11) Other key volunteer positions: Video recording, Safety coordinators, Medical Officers need to be recruited.
- 12) **Tang June and Ken Chan** will co-host the celebration gala.
- 13) Other topics:
 - (I) It has been suggested that Raffle gifts should be new with a minimum of \$10 value. Please do not wrap the gift when you donate it and let the receptionist know the value as well.
 - (II). It is decided that the program start at 2pm and the dinner will be served at 5:30 pm.

In the next month or so, Jim Jiang will contact OCCA members for more volunteer positions. Please contact Jim at jiangq01@gmail.com if you would like to help.

Note: Some of the job assignments were not discussed in detail during the meeting. Jim Jiang will be fully responsible for the decision.
