OCCA Hosts APAHM Panel Discussion about Youth Experiences

The month of May marks the start of Asian American and Pacific Islander Heritage Month (APAHM). This national observance is a time for people to not only recognize the contributions and rich history of our AAPI communities in America, but also to acknowledge the challenges and hate that we have faced and received. On Friday, May 13th, 2022, the Orange County Chinese Association (OCCA) Youth Group and Student Government hosted a Zoom panel discussion surrounding the topic of the Asian identity's impact on young adults and students in our community. The discussion managed to explore and understand the challenges, experiences, and characteristics of the Asian identity on a deeper level. Our cast of panelists featured Dr. Roger Chao, Ms. Katie Luo, and Ms. Rachel Shih, all of whom are now working young adults or attending college and are active members in our OCCA community. OCCA member Jeffery Shi acted as the facilitator for this panel discussion.

To kick off the meeting, we had a diverse group of speakers give a few opening remarks that allowed them to share their experiences APAHM and the surrounding community. The speakers included State Senator James Skoufis, Assemblyman Colin Schmitt, Dr. Lan Jiang (OCCA Vice President), and Mr. Ken Chan (OCCS Principal). Throughout the meeting, our panelists shared a variety of perspectives in response questions regarding to characteristics and impact of the Asian identity, challenges that have affected them personally, and resilience that they have shown as an Asian-American in today's less than optimal landscape. Despite having distinct experiences and ideas, there were a few common themes that persisted throughout the conversation. One of them was struggling with their Asian identity at a young age while living and attending school in a predominantly white area. The panelists voiced their thoughts about how at times, all they wanted to do was fit in. This challenge emerged due to the lack

of engagement with other Asians in our community, leading to a feeling of isolation and being singled out. It is important to embrace our unique AAPI identities and especially critical in our social climate nowadays with the spike in anti-Asian hate crimes and violence. The panelists all agreed that it is crucial to find support in our Asian community and band together to speak out against the hate and injustices that we may face in America. To close out the meeting, each one of the panelists shared a piece of advice for our OCCA youth community members.

This panel discussion about the Asian identity's effects on our young adults and students provides a new outlook on the Asian American experience. Although there are many obstacles that our community members have to face, Asian Americans have a long and rich history in this country, featuring many successes and accomplishments that should be recognized.






Orange County Chinese Association Celebrates Mother's Day


