《首届哈德逊谷地区"中文图书制作"竞赛颁奖》江岚 (Continue)

5月18日下午,纽约州哈德逊大区中学生首届 "Create Chinese book"大赛的颁奖晚餐在橙郡-爱斯特郡教育局 (Orange-Ulster BOCES' Arden Hill Regional Learning Center, Goshen, New York)举办。

OU BOCES 从 2008 年开始,在各学区逐步展开汉语课程,负责组织师资,横向展开课程设置和教学活动。现有从 7 年级到 12 年级,十八个不同进阶班级,注册汉语学生总计近三百余名。此次比赛本来是教育局优秀的资深汉语教师何谦在自己的课堂上组织的一个教学活动。让学生在家庭、学校、动植物、文化、运动等范围内自选一个主题,在固定的格式规定下制作出一本图文并茂的儿童书。这一项富有创造性、趣味性和挑战性的课堂活动后来扩展为面向 OU BOCES 辖区内各校中文学生的竞赛,并得到了橙郡中文学校、橙郡华人协会的积极协助和大力支持。

比赛历时一个月,来自7个不同学区、不同年级、不同汉语进阶班的67名学生参加了比赛。当日的颁奖活动评选出三大组共九名获奖者,分别是:

汉语作为第二外语-高中生组:

第一名: Ms. Arianna Ostojic - Brewster High School

第二名: Mr. Ryan Castle - Wallkill Senior High School

第三名: Mr. Isaac Walker - James I O' Neill High School

汉语作为第二外语-初中生组:

第一名: Ms. Lian Walker - Warwick Valley Middle School

第二名: Ms. Allison King - Warwick Valley Middle School

第三名: Ms. Shirley Chen - Warwick Valley Middle School

汉语作为承继语-初中生组:

第一名: Mr. Derek Li - Monroe-Woodbury Middle School

第二名: Angela Qiu - Cornwall Middle School

第三名: Sunny Shi - Middletown Middle School

OU BOCES 为辖区内各学区的学生们提供的汉语课程,主要以视频课堂的方式进行。高科技手段的运用,为想选修汉语的学生提供了学习机会,也成功地解决了面积广阔的大哈德逊谷大区各校相距太远,难于独立组织小语种教学并形成规模的难题。2008 年以来,远程汉语教学的模式得到了学生、家长和各参与学校的积极肯定,得到了稳步发展。现在的课程设置当中,高级班的汉语课程已经和纽约州立大学系统内的一些高校开始合作,让学生们能够在高中阶段同时拿到大学的课程学分,一方面完成中、高等教育里汉语教学的衔接,另一方面也为学生设置了客观上实用而具体的学习目标。







纽约州的外语教学课程标准,要求学生们通过外语学习增强自身的语言交际技能与综合文化素质,"中文图书制作"的活动不仅是这项标准在教学过程中的有效实施,也有力地推动了学生们学习汉语、运用汉语、喜爱中华文化的兴趣。获奖的学生们当天都获得了由 Orange-Ulster BOCES 教育局提供的奖杯、证书,以及橙郡中文学校、橙郡华人协会提供的中英双语中国全景介绍《China》。OU BOCES 中文项目主任 Diane Lang 博士主持颁奖仪式,橙郡华人协会会长吴康健博士、副会长江岚博士、橙郡中文学校史秀全校长应邀出席颁奖活动。三方表示今后将继续合作,为推动哈德逊大区的中国语言文化传播共同努力。


